Just a Reminder: In conjunction with Article IV, Section 3, of these By-Laws, accounts will be closed out the last day of each month and statement rendered by the fifth (5th) of the following month with payment due by the twentieth (20th) of the month. If not paid by the end of the month of the billing, names of the delinquent account will be posted and charging privileges withdrawn until payment is made. In conjunction with Article IV, Section 3, the delinquent member shall be reported to the Board of Directors. If on the thirtieth (30th) of the next month (forty ((40)) days from the due date) the account is unpaid, the membership will then be subject to termination and the delinquent member's name may be turned over to a collection agency. **Unavoidable exceptions to the above, must be discussed with the Treasurer.**
