Office News

Also, Karen has requested that you pay your bill in accordance with Article XI, Section 6, Item C.

In conjunction with Article IV, Section 3, of these By-Laws, accounts will be closed out the last day of each month and statement rendered by the fifth (5th) of the following month with payment due by the twentieth (20th) of the month. If not paid by the end of the month of the billing, names of the delinquent account will be posted and charging privileges withdrawn until payment is made. In conjunction with Article IV, Section 3, the delinquent member shall be reported to the Board of Directors. If on the thirtieth (30th) of the next month (forty ((40)) days from the due date) the account is unpaid, the membership will then be subject to termination and the delinquent member's name may be turned over to a collection agency. Unavoidable exceptions to the above, must be discussed with the Treasurer.

Labor Day Weekend

Security will be provided at the gate for the Labor Day weekend on the 4th, 5th, & 6th of September. The Club appreciates your cooperation in following the By-laws and Constitution of the Club during this weekend and all other days of the season.

As the Labor Day weekend rapidly approaches, it is again necessary to remind the membership that there is a four (4) day limit for camping without the approval of the Board of Directors for

an extended stay (see Article II, Section 4 d of the CBC By-laws). The camping available at the Casper Boat Club is limited and on a first come, first serve basis. Daisy chaining is not allowed. If you are daisy chained, the cord will be removed from the box and the box will be locked.

Also...

In accordance with Article XI Section 4 of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Casper Boat Club, No dogs, cats, animals or reptiles will be allowed on the Club premises at any time except for traveling to and from a member's boat and only then when controlled by a leash. A member shall be responsible for any "mess" so created by his pet. All droppings must be picked up, bagged and removed from the Club premises. Upon receiving a **written** complaint addressed to the Board of Directors, the following action will be taken.

1st offense – Secretary sends a warning letter to the offender.

2nd offense – The member's privilege of having any pet on the Club grounds is revoked.

3rd offense – The member's membership is terminated.
