The Board is currently working on several matters, i.e. 2006 operating budget, long-term capital budgeting, and 2006 club improvements. We will notify the general membership as discussion regarding these issues progress. In summary, the basic focus of the Board of Directors in 2006 are consistent with our mission last year: To be judicious in the management of CBC resources, provide a profitable food and beverage operation with an amiable staff that provides above average service in the Dining and Lounge area of the Club. Sheryll Ulrich, whose expertise in which the food and beverage finances resulted in a dramatic turnaround in 2005, will be returning this summer. We are very fortunate to have Sheryll as the 2006 Manager and are confident in her ability to build on the strengths that she demonstrated last year.

We will continue to invest in repairs and maintenance to enhance the general appearance of the Grounds, Facilities and Docks, while improving the overall financial health of the Club for its members. The CBC was reviewed by the ADA (American Disabilities Act) and we anticipate recommendations that will direct the Board to make investments within our facilities to address those issues and concerns so as to bring the Casper Boat Club into compliance in a timely manner. The Federal Government is Casper Boat Club's Landlord and ADA recommendations must be addressed in an acceptable timely fashion.

Please be aware that all Casper Boat club membership accounts need to be paid in full and current as of 1 March 2006. Those memberships not current will be considered closed and forfeited as to allow, during the month of March 2006, CBC dock assignments, CBC Membership Cards, 2006 CBC Stickers for Boats/Trailers and CBC Membership rosters to be completed. If a CBC member elects, installments can be made on their respective account so as to have the total amount due paid by 1 March 2006.

The Board of Directors feels that with a continued conservative financial approach, thoughtful investment in facilities and membership involvement will continue to enhance your club and facilities. I would ask for your patience, support and especially your involvement in your club. The entire Board is open to suggestions and comments from every member.
