After 6:00 p.m., casual dress, reflecting a reasonable standard of grooming and decorum, is required throughout the Club.

We would ask that all members, and their guests, enjoy this area by dressing in "resort casual" attire that would include "collared shirts" for men. Please refrain from wearing T-shirts in this dining room. We would also remind you that as members you are responsible for your guests, their appearance, and their behavior. Please do not invite your friends to use our facilities in your absence.

Don't forget that a \$75.00 **monthly assessment** is levied May thru August on every CBC member. This assessment must be used in food and beverage purchases at the Casper Boat Club only. We really want you to enjoy what the club has to offer and failing to consume this minimum prevents our staff from having the pleasure of serving you and your guests.
