GREETINGS FROM THE COMMODORE

Winter continues to “MARCH” along!! February is now behind us and the count-down clock on the CBC web site is keeping us informed as to how many days before the club opens. He has made this site into a very informative, interesting and useful aid. Everyone is encouraged to look at the information contained and refer it to any interested friends or associates.

During the February Board of Directors monthly meeting several issues were evaluated and discussed. One measure was the \$40.00 fee for reserved parking of empty boat trailers on the CBC Grounds. Several factors were evaluated i.e. expenditure of monies to place signage, parking spaces defined, gravel assigned areas, removal of existing telephone poles, how this area will be monitored, and associated rules and regulations. It became very evident that when the Board made their original decision; not all of these issues had been properly addressed. It was therefore decided by a unanimous vote to rescind the \$40.00 fee. All members that have paid this \$40.00 fee will have their accounts credited, or if desired they can ask Karen for a refund. I must emphasize that periodically, during the summer season, there will be inspections of trailers for proper identification, as required by the CBC rules and regulations and registration per Wyoming State law. Each trailer is required to have a CBC sticker on the tongue and Wyoming law requires that the trailer be properly tagged and registered for the current year (2005). If either condition is found to not conform to these rules; steps will be taken to resolve the issue or have the trailer removed by the Sheriff’s Department from the CBC Grounds. Please make sure that your trailer is in compliance.

The Casper Boat Club will have our first function of the year April 2, 2005. It will be the Commodore’s Party and will be held at the Casper Petroleum Club. Lynn Burgess has organized this event and there will be many activities. A special flyer will be sent out identifying the meal offerings and associated events. Reservations are required so that the CPC Manager (Sandy) and his staff can plan accordingly. Please take the time to attend this function – it will be an excellent beginning of the 2005 season. This is a great opportunity to renew old friendships and discuss your past winter’s activities. We look forward to seeing you there!
