### FAQ

- Q. Are there rule concerning having pets on the club grounds?
- A. Yes, per the club by laws, " No dogs, cats, animals or reptiles will be allowed on the Club premises at any time except for traveling to and from a member's boat and only then when controlled by a leash. A member shall be responsible for any "mess" so created by his pet. All droppings must be picked up, bagged and removed from the Club premises."
- Q. Can I transfer my membership and rented slip space to a family member or friend, or can I leave it to someone as part of my estate in the event of my death?
- A. No. Memberships and slip spaces belong only to the member and co-member. Further, only a spouse can be a co-member. When a member leaves the club giving up his or her membership, the membership ends and the slip goes into the regular slip pool to be reassigned per the policies of the slip waiting list.

A few reminders. First, be aware of the no-wake zones around the club, especially in back bay. This is a state boating regulation and you are responsible for your wake. Second, members are responsible for the behavior of their guests and minor children.
