FAQ

Q. Is there a limit to the number of times I can bring a guest to the club?

A. Yes, per the club by laws you may bring a guest to the club five (5) times a year. Guests cannot charge at the club and they must be accompanied by a member. Members are responsible for the behavior of their guests and any damage to Club Property caused by their guests. Adult children age twenty-two (22) are considered guests and are governed by all rules that apply to guests.

Q. Can the club sell gasoline to the public?

A. No. The club can only sell gasoline to members. Furthermore, members cannot buy gasoline for guests, friends and such and have the guest reimburse them. Gasoline sales are for members' usage only.

Q. Can I buy alcohol from the club "to go"?

A. No, the club's liquor license does not allow package sales so all alcohol sold must be opened and consumed at the club.
