Park Rules and Regulations

The Natrona County Sheriff's Department wants to remind members that the Casper Boat Club is not private property. All park rules and laws, including traffic laws, will be enforced by the Sheriff's Department on Casper Boat Club Grounds.

Dogs

According to the Casper Boat Club Bylaws: No dogs, cats, animals or reptiles will be allowed on the Club premises at any time except for traveling to and from a member's boat and only then when controlled by a leash. A member shall be responsible for any "mess" so created by his pet. All droppings must be picked up, bagged and removed from the Club premises. Upon receiving written complaint addressed to the Board of Directors, the following action will be taken.

1st Offense - Secretary sends a warning letter to the offender.

2nd Offense - The member's privilege of having any pet on the Club grounds is revoked.

3rd Offense - The member's membership is terminated.

According to rule #8 of the Camping Rules and Regulations that were sent out earlier this year: No pets are allowed on the Swim Beach, on Club House Porch/Deck or in Club House. Owners are responsible for keeping dogs from barking.
