At this year's board meeting there will be 3 open board seats. If you have interest in becoming a board member please contact Bob Hopkins, Gary Rowe, or Dave Herman.



**PLEASE TAKE NOTE**-Dress code from the by-laws:

Article XI, Section 6, paragraph D4: *Shirts and shoes are required in the Lounge and Dining Room at all times.
