

Dues increase of \$50 was presented by the Board of Directors at the Annual meeting. There was also an assessment of \$100 for the 2018 season that will be billed and due by March 1, 2018. The assessment is for the beginning phases of rebuilding the bulkhead. The estimate costs to complete the project are estimated to be around \$250,000.
